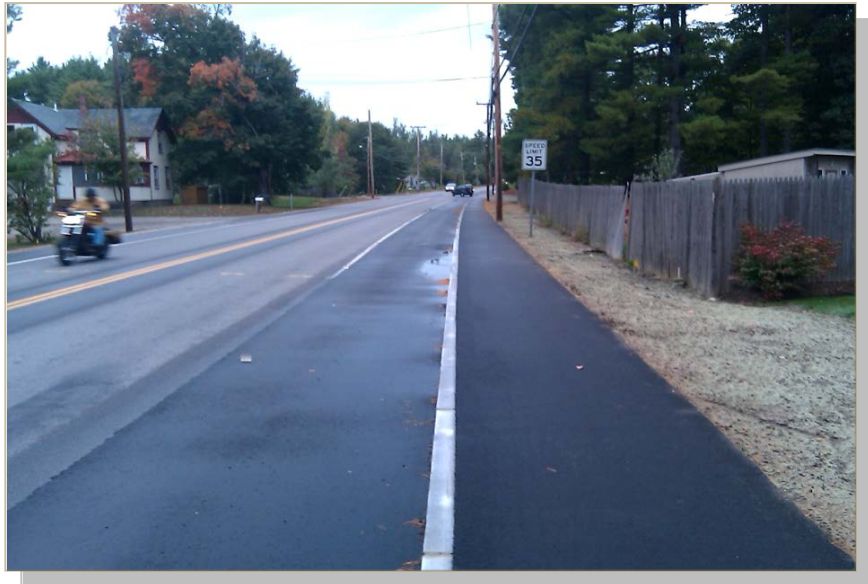

DESCRIPTION

The Town of Hudson desired a pedestrian sidewalk that would connect with the recent roadway and sidewalk improvements just south of Alvirne High School. The Town of Hudson, in coordination with NH Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Administration, proposed the construction of a new 5-foot-wide bituminous pedestrian sidewalk with granite curb on the east side of Derry Street (NH Route 102) in Hudson, NH. The sidewalk extends approximately 4,500 feet, between Evergreen Drive and Megan Drive, connecting with the recent roadway and sidewalk improvements just south of Alvirne High School.

An existing underground utility conflict was discovered during the project layout phase. CLD and the private utility company worked together to develop an affordable compatible design. Unfortunately due to budget restrictions by the utility company, the project was delayed one season.

The project involves improving the overall safety for bicyclists and pedestrians on Derry Street from the intersection with Evergreen Drive to Megan Drive. Improvements include adding a bike lane, new sidewalk construction, sidewalk upgrades and pedestrian safety enhancements, curbing and ramps. This project is funded through the TE Program State Project 13894/Federal Project X-A000(095).
